Sabina Hill brings First Nations imagery from the Northwest Coast to furniture with a contemporary feel.

Working with Andy Everson, Hill has created the limited edition New Spirit collection of wall panels and coffee tables. Using bronze anodized aluminum, tempered glass top, solid wood and makore wood veneer, the Prow coffee table stands out as a piece of art in itself. The bronze anodized aluminum is laser cut with the image entitled *Whale and Human Face*, which Everson designed. *The Prow* is currently on display at Canada House Gallery in Banff, where Hill's is regularly presented. Sabina Hill studied architecture at the University of British Columbia and has practised furniture building and interior design since 1993.
